
A professional team of muralists will create an art mural for your school through this program.






Photography & Film

Our introductory program teaches students photography, video, and editing using programs like Adobe Premiere, Photoshop, among others, in a fast-paced way. It covers primary effects, working with text and images, creating online content, and more. Students will use their cell phones to develop introductory skills. The course covers shooting, editing, media management, storytelling, audio, color correction, and online publishing. Through group critiques, students develop language for analyzing media works.





Performing Arts

Elementary - Middle - High School

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
The program offers a variety of activities, including acting, dance, and culture, to positively impact a child's development. Students will improve their confidence, social skills, and performance abilities and conclude with a theatrical or musical performance in the class. A final presentation could be arranged for an additional cost.

VOICE

Our vocal music program teaches voice, focusing on a pedagogical-musical plan. It includes cultural and therapeutic activities that develop the psychomotor system of all ages. The program fosters cognitive and artistic skills while promoting cultural understanding.

MULTICULTURAL DANCE

Our multicultural dance program offers classes that enhance creativity, movement skills, and cognitive abilities. The program aims to boost self-esteem, self-awareness, and overall well-being while introducing students to at least two dance forms from different cultures: salsa merengue, tango, samba, cumbia, flamenco, hip hop and others.





Urban Gardening

Elementary - Middle - High School

Our program combines gardening and art to encourage creativity, increase student engagement with nature, and develop sensorial capacity and fine motor control. Students will learn about different plant types, soil properties, ancient medicinal plants, and the garden alphabet while discovering art anywhere.

Our teacher incorporate art into the lessons plans to help students practice color recognition, learn about mixing colors, and explore different artistic expressions and artists inspired by nature. The program includes fun art projects such as decorating pots and designing creative garden signs.
